- Diving is not included in the charter. However, diving is available if requested at the time of making your booking and is only available to qualified divers. Full evidence of diving qualifications along with certificates, cards, log books etc must be shown to Captain in advance. Diving will be done under the Captain's supervision. An additional cost of S\$50 per dive per person is charged.

Crew – Functions & Responsibilities

Skipper

- The skipper is a high skill person, very knowledgeable in navigation and manoeuvring the yacht as well as in technical.
- The skipper manages and is responsible for the security of the yacht and will provide the security briefing to the Charterer.
- The skipper manages and is responsible for the operation of the yacht.
- The skipper manages and is responsible for maintenance and good work of the yacht's equipment and system which includes: Engine, Generator, A/C, Watermaker, Electronic etc.
- The skipper is responsible of manoeuvring the yacht.
- The skipper advises on route planning and itinerary choices of the Charterer and provides general information about the sailing area as a "guide".
- The skipper participates in serving food and cleaning after meals.

Cook / Deck Hand

- A cook / deckhand is in charge of both preparing meals and cleaning the interior of the yacht.
- For the reason a cook / deck hand will not provide "gourmet" food but will prepare high quality "regular" meals.
- The cook / deckhand is in charge of preparing meals for Charterer as well as for crew.
- The cook / deck hand is in charge of maintenance and good work of all cooking equipment onboard.
- The cook / deck hand is in charge, with Skipper's help, of cleaning of kitchen including cooking equipment and crockery after each meal.

Crew Notes

Crew must have their own cabin. Therefore, the maximum passenger numbers (8 pax) must be adhered to.

We require a fully completed passenger list with details of all passengers joining the charter at least 2 weeks in advance of the commencement of the charter. A blank crew list is attached. To help us to provide the perfect cruise we ask that Charterers complete a "preference" questionnaire and submit it along with the crew list. This information will be passed onto the crew and will ensure that they make your charter the best it can be.
